


Optos Retinal Imaging offers the following advantages;

- 1) Optos Retinal Imaging allows us to snap a picture of the back of your eyes in a matter of seconds and keep that image attached to your medical record as long as you are a patient here. We review these images against current photos yearly in order to detect subtle changes in the back of your eyes. This results in the ability to catch eye diseases such as glaucoma, macular degeneration, retinal bleeding from hypertension, among others, much earlier than previously possible.
- 2) We visually evaluate the health of the back of your eyes each and every year through the use of Optos Imaging or through a standard Dilated exam (drops instilled in eyes to allow for better view by the doctor) In most cases, a dilated retinal exam is not warranted if Optos Retinal Imaging is chosen. In rare instances, if something is seen on Optos that your doctor wants to evaluate through a dilated exam, we will gladly not charge you for Optos images. Again, this is rare, but important for the ongoing health of your eyes.
